

MESSAGE FROM OUR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

I am proud to present an overview of the achievements of Shepherd's Clinic in Fiscal Year 23, highlighting our commitment to providing integrated, holistic health and wellness programs and services to the Baltimore community. Building on our legacy that spans over 30 years, we continue to address the critical healthcare needs of low-income, uninsured adults.

In the past year, Shepherd's Clinic successfully served 857 individuals through 2,705 appointments and conducted over 9,660 patient encounters, reflecting a 7% increase from the previous year. We consistently receive positive feedback from virtually all patients, reflecting high service satisfaction. This positive trend is a testament to our commitment to providing excellent care.

We have witnessed a significant increase in language translation utilization, with over 200% growth since last year. We offer access to over 240 languages, including American Sign Language. This improves the care of our ever-growing, diverse patient population.

Shepherd's Clinic continued to address social determinants of health, offering essential resources such as transportation, insurance enrollment, and food resources. Medical services remain a core focus, with 164 medical clinic volunteers. While most of our services are provided at the Clinic, we served 334 community members with free health screenings. Our Behavioral Health Services, enhanced by adding a social work supervisor, expanded service offerings and forged new community partnerships. Wellness Services, executed by five volunteers, expanded to 88 unique participants.

As we look ahead to Fiscal Year 24, community outreach remains a focal point. Our primary programs, including EMPOWER, TRIUMPH, and IGNITE, aim to treat high blood pressure, manage diabetes, and provide vaccines to strengthen community health.

We thank those who help with our work, including our dedicated volunteers, staff, board, granting organizations, and individual donors. Your continued engagement enables Shepherd's Clinic to make a lasting impact on the well-being of our community.



In addition to Medical, Behavioral Health, and Wellness services, patients completed 762 referrals for visits for follow-up care. 95% of patients receiving medication from the Clinic were compliant with their medication adherence.

WILLIAM H. M. FINNEY FOUNDATION

The idea for a clinic dedicated to serving uninsured people took root in 1989 in response to Union Memorial Hospital's emergency room seeing a large number of uninsured individuals who found no other alternative for their healthcare. After learning about the grassroots effort to establish a clinic for those in need. Dr. William Finney, retired UMH chief of staff, joined as the Shepherd's Clinic's first volunteer medical director. In 1999, several Clinic supporters created a foundation and named it in Dr. Finney's honor. The Foundation purchased and renovated the building at 2800 Kirk Ave. It continues to provide tremendous support to the Clinic and the Joy Wellness Center by providing rent-free space and operating grants to assist the Clinic in meeting its expenses.
